Harriet Tubman Home and Historical Park

Harriet Tubman was an escaped slave who helped with the Underground Railroad to assist freeing other slaves. She established a house for the sick, aged and homeless. Auburn, NY Open 10-2 daily by appointment 10 miles

Designer and manufacturer of unique pieces and collections of kitchen and dining décor, furniture and outdoor features. Aurora, NY Tours and store 10-5 Daily 8 miles

Montezuma National Wildlife Refuge

Area of wildlife, birds, and habitat. Three mile observation drive, trails, platforms, towers and Visitor Center. Wildlife Drive open sunrise to sunset. Visitor Center 10-3 All weather permitting 10 miles

Taughannock Falls State Park Tallest single falls east of the Rocky Mountains. 215' Viewing, hiking, camping, picnicking, swimming, etc. Trumansburg, NY 42 miles

Hiram Edson Farm SDA Heritage Museum and Bible Prophecy Trail Clifton Springs, NY Open May-November 30 miles

The Great Gully Ravine, waterfalls and pool. Open year round. 3 miles south
